

At Central Assembly, we enjoy having the opportunity to love, teach and watch your children grow. We love them so much that we are asking our parents to help us minister to your children better. The way you can do that is by helping us with the following things.

Drop Off / Pick Up

The drop off time for every children's ministry service or event is 15 minutes prior to the start. The pick up time is within 15 minutes of the service or event ending. When service ends on Sunday's, please pick up your children immediately at the close of service.

Supervision

Please help us protect your children by ensuring they are under your direct supervision while not participating in a service or event. This protects your child from getting hurt in a crowded hallway with adults and also protects adults from tripping or falling accidentally over any children and getting hurt as well. At no time should a child be anywhere in the building without adult supervision.

Sanctuary

After most services, we encourage people to remain in the sanctuary for a time of prayer. It's our goal to not disturb them during that prayer time. By making sure your children aren't in the sanctuary immediately after each service this helps us achieve that goal.

We know that the instruments on stage are a tremendous temptation to children, and rightfully so. They're shiny and make wonderful noise. But we ask that you help us protect your children by not allowing them to go onto the stage at anytime. There are wires and cables they can trip on and get hurt as well as expensive personal and church instruments that can be broken. Your help here ensures their physical safety and limits damage to equipment.

Thank you for helping us provide safe and effective ministry to your children. We are excited to partner with you in teaching your children about the love of God and His purpose for their lives.
