1. A Parent's Love: Our Father.

Psalm 27:10 Though my father and mother forsake me, the LORD will receive me.(NIV)

2. The Presence of God: Hallowed be Your name.

Jireh	My Provider
Rapha	My Healer
Shalom	My Peace
Shamah	Is There
Nissi	My Banner
Rohi	My Shepherd

3. Priorities: Your kingdom come. Your will be done.

Proverbs 3:5 Trust in the LORD with all your heart and lean not on your own understanding; 6 in all your ways acknowledge him, and he will make your paths straight. (NIV)

Prayer Points:

- God's will for your life. (Ephesians 5:17_
- Family (Psalm 112:1-3)
- Pastor, Church, Revival
- Government: local, state, national (2 Chronicles 7:14, 1 Timothy 2:1-4)

4. Provision: Give us this day our daily bread. (Psalm 35:27)

Malachi 3:10 Test me in this," says the LORD Almighty, "and see if I will not throw open the floodgates of heaven and pour out so much blessing that you will not have room enough for it. (NIV)

- Pray for God's spiritual blessing in your life today.
- Pray for God to prosper you.
- Pray for God to deliver you from debt.
- Ask God to bless the local church to do His work.

5. Pardon: And forgive us our debts, As we forgive our debtors. (Isaiah 1:18)

- Ask for forgiveness & give forgiveness to others.
- Pray for your enemies.

6. Power: And do not lead us into temptation, But deliver us from the evil one.

Exodus 9:16 But I have raised you up for this very purpose, that I might show you my power and that my name might be proclaimed in all the earth. (NIV)

- Pray for divine appointments.
- Put on the Armor of God (Ephesians 6:13-18)
- Release the Gifts of the Spirit (1 Corinthians 12)

7. Praise: For Yours is the kingdom and the power and the glory forever. Amen.

2 Timothy 4:18 The Lord will rescue me from every evil attack and will bring me safely to his heavenly kingdom. To him be glory for ever and ever. Amen. (NIV)

We start our prayer with praise, and we close our prayer with praise.

This last part forces us to keep a right perspective.
